1. Apologies were received from Councillors Pascoe, Slade-Elmes & Cllr Tovey
2. Matters arising from the last Annual Parish Meeting None.
3. To receive the Chairman's report  
Cllr Pocock reviewed his report for the past year and outlined the key objectives for the forthcoming year.
4. Reports from Organisations
  - i. CD&GWI – The Chairman read out the report from the WI which thanked the Parish Council for the donation towards a new kitchen. The report said that the walls would now be repainted and new flooring would be laid to finish the new kitchen.
  - ii. PTR A – The Chairman read out the report which thanked the Parish Council for the donation towards an ipod and docking station for the youth club. The report also advised that the Halloween disco went very well along with the fireworks display. The group had also held a Christmas party and second quiz night and was on track with their plans for a Jubilee barbeque.

  - iii. Wall Hall – Mr Butterfield thanked the Parish Council for its donation towards a new heating system for the hall and said that it had made a vast difference to the area. They had also refurbished the hall and kitchen and would be setting up a new committee to take forward the complete refurbishment of Wall Hall.
  - iv. Wall Music Festival – Mr Butterfield said that the festival was the largest multi day event within the Parish and was a big success story. He advised that they had received around 350 entries this year and have had to extend the event by another day, meaning it runs from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May through to Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> May. Mr Butterfield said the Parish Council grant would help pay for the adjudicator and was very grateful for our ongoing support.
  - v. St Gwinear Parish Church – The Chairman read out the report which thanked the Parish Council for its grant towards the community notice board which would be erected shortly.
  - vi. Gwinear Churchtown Football Club – The Chairman read out the report which outlined the history of the club and thanked the Parish Council for their grant which would go towards the running of the club for a further season.
  - vii. Community Action Through Sport – The Chairman read out the report which thanked the Council for their donation and advised that the branch had arranged swimming and surfing sessions and these would be awarded to nominated young persons in June, any nominations should be directed to Cllr Dave Cupples.
