



How to register with Cornwall Council to receive notification of planning applications in your area

The best way to ensure you are notified of planning applications near you is to register with the planning authority Cornwall Council to receive emails when an application comes up in your area.

Gwinear-Gwithian Parish Council has put together this step by step guide with pictures to help its parishioners navigate Cornwall Council's planning register.

1. You can do this by visiting Cornwall Council's planning register at planning.cornwall.gov.uk/online-applications

5. Once you have registered return to the planning register at planning.cornwall.gov.uk/online-applications and scroll down until you see the tab for 'weekly/monthly lists' and click 'weekly/monthly lists' tab:-

Please be aware that if your key word is not in the application address it will not show up in your search so I would always advise setting your criteria at Parish level. Please also remember if you live on a Parish border such as 'Roseworthy' you should consider saving two searches one for Gwinear-Gwithian Parish and one for Camborne Parish, you can narrow your search down by ward for Camborne as well.
