❖ The extreme northern corner of the parish is within the AONB and a short section of the parish boundary runs along the AONB boundary. A small part of Godrevy Head to St Agnes SSSI and approximately half of the Gwithian to Mexico Towans SSSI lie within the parish. Godrevy Head is cited for the rock, raised beach and cliff formations and nesting birds. Both sites contain dune systems which support a number of rare native plants, butterflies and moths. Parts of the parish area are designated as AONB and Heritage Coast.
