

Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting of Gwinear-Gwithian Parish Council held on Monday 25th November 2024 at Gwinear-Gwithian Parish Hall, Copper Meadows, Reawla, Gwinear, Hayle, TR27 5FN commencing at 7.00pm.

1. Routine matters

Seconded by Cllr Pickering with all in favour the proposal was RESOLVED. The grant budget now being £1100.

- c) To receive quotations regarding fire safety compliance and agree the way forward. Cllr Gill proposed quote 1 be approved for the review only, seconded by Cllr Cupples with all in favour the proposal was RESOLVED.
- d) To consider a response to a Consultation on updating the Bathing Water Regulations. Cllr Cupples proposed the draft response be submitted, seconded by Cllr Pascoe with all in favour the proposal was RESOLVED.
- e) To receive information regarding Gwithian Green Pound and agree the way forward. A debate ensued with various concerns and questions asked. The meeting agreed to defer the item until the first January meeting.
- f) To discuss acquiring a flag and pole for the Parish Hall – Cllr Gill. After a brief debate the meeting agreed that now was not the time to consider this and deferred the item for one year.
